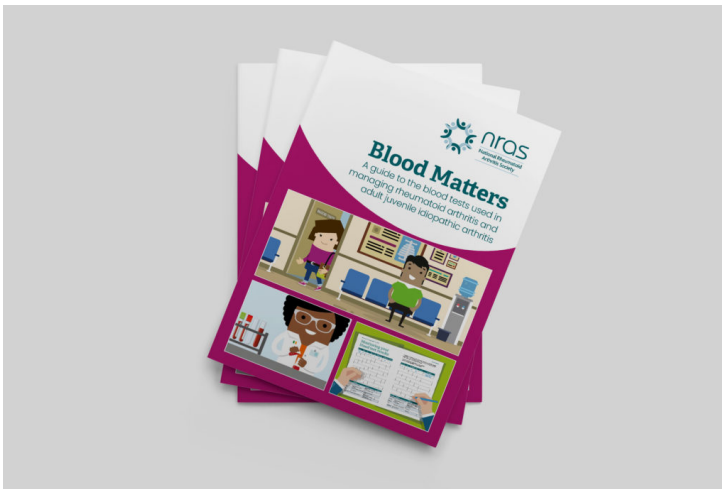
# Blood Matters
